- 1. SECTION I TO BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY APPLICANT.
- 2. ACT/SAT results should be attached if entering first year of college. High school transcripts generally include this information. If so, this is acceptable.
- 3. (a) If you are entering first year of college, attach most recent high school transcript. If you are in your first year of college now, attach most recent high school transcript together with your college transcript.
 - (b) If you are currently attending college, attach most recent college transcript
- 4. Attach a one-page essay (typed) on why you want to further your education and why you are a viable candidate for this scholarship. If you are working a part-time job, please explain job and why you have chosen to work.

 MUST SIGN ESSAY
- 5. Current letter of reference, signed by reference giver, from high school/college faculty member
- 6. Current letter of reference, signed by reference giver, from a person of your choice (other than family or faculty member) who can attest to your character, ability and determination.
- 7. Return completed application and supporting documents.
