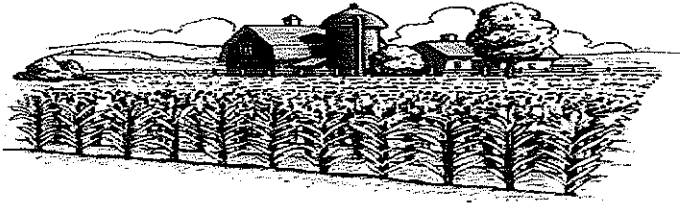

I have enclosed a flyer that explains the scholarship application process in more detail. You may make as many copies as necessary.

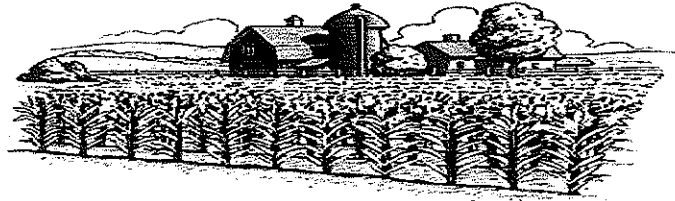

Addie Halsey Scholarship

- Sponsor:** Maquon United Methodist Church
- Eligibility:** Graduating High School Senior living in Knox County or attending Spoon River Valley Schools.
- Value:** \$1,000.00 per year. Available for four consecutive years if the student Continues to meet the criteria and in good standing with the college And their major is in an area related to agriculture.
- Criteria:** Scholarship ability and achievement; community and school activities; citizenship. Pursuing an advanced education in an area related to agriculture.
- Application:** Submit a resume which includes school and community activities, interest in agricultural fields, the field in agriculture to be pursued in advanced education and how that field will be used in the future. Applicants must also send an official transcript, which includes class rank, GPA, and standardized test results. At least one letter of recommendation from someone other than a relative in an agricultural field should also be included.
