1) Elks Most Valuable Student Competition - \$50,000 - 500 Awards (Deadline: November 15, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- B) Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.

2) James Cox Student Photography Scholarships - \$2,500 - 11 Awards (Deadline: November 15, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) High school students applying for these scholarships must have completed one year at an accredited high school (student must therefore be a sophomore or older) and should have taken at least one photography or related art class.

3) Real World Design Challenge Scholarships - \$50,000 - 7 Awards (Deadline: November 17, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled in grade nine, ten, eleven or twelve. Students enrolled in school environments with alternative grade or level designations must be engaged in a program of study equivalent to the corresponding high school grade level.

4) Dr Juan Andrade Jr. Scholarship - \$1,000 - 20 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as full-time undergraduate students, in an accredited institution in the U.S. or U.S. territories, and demonstrate a verifiable need for financial support.

B) Have at least one parent of Hispanic ancestry

5) National Space Club Scholarship - \$10,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a senior in high school.

B) Have the intention of pursuing a career in the STEM fields.

6) VIP Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a United States citizen and currently be enrolled in college or high school

B) Be at least 13 years of age or older.

7) Sixt Scholarship Program - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Have a minimum 3.7 GPA on a 4.0 scale

B) Be a graduating high school senior in the USA, academic year 2018/2019

8) HP Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a legal resident of the 50 United States and DC
- B) Be 13 years or older at the time of entry

9) SP Scholarships - \$10,000 – 10 Awards (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) Be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

10) Genius Loci Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: November 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.
- B) Be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.

11) Barbara Lotze Scholarships for Future Teachers - \$2,000 – 5 Awards (Deadline: December 1, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) An undergraduate student enrolled in an accredited two-year college, four-year college or a university; or a high school senior accepted for such enrollment.
- B) Pursuing, or planning to pursue, a course of study leading toward a career in physics teaching in the high schools.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a college student or anyone planning on attending college (or another form of higher education) in the 2019/2020 school year and have a valid driver's license.

13) Stephen J. Brady Stop Hunger Scholarships - \$5,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: December 5, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be enrolled in an accredited educational institution (kindergarten through graduate school) in the US.

B) Have demonstrated on-going commitment to their community by performing unpaid volunteer services.

14) AXA Achievement Scholarship - \$25,000 - 52 Awards (Deadline: December 14, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be United States citizens or legal residents living or claiming residency in one of the 50 united states, Washington, D.C. or Puerto Rico

B) Be current high school seniors who plan to enroll full-time in an accredited two-year or four-year college
